WHO IS THE GROUP DESIGNED TO SERVE?

Youths ages 11 to 18 who are learning disabled or have attention deficit disorders and who may:

- ◆ Avoid social contact
- ◆ Behave immaturely
- ◆ Be shy, or timid in groups
- ◆ Experience conflict with peers

WHO CAN BE A MENTOR?

- ◆ Successful young adults either in college/ university or in the work force
- ◆ Likes and enjoys adolescents
- ◆ Knowledgeable about the challenges and struggles people face with learning disabilities and attention deficit disorders
- ◆ Strong leadership, communication and social skills
- ◆ A team player
- ◆ Passionate about helping others



Once application form is completed, an interview will be schedule to see if you fit best with the program. If approved then training will be provided. Based on the nature of this program, a police check is required and it is expected that upon applying you are committing to the entire 7 month session. Mentoring will be once or twice a month running from April 2010 to October 2010 on Saturday Afternoon.

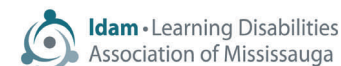
